Keratoconjunctivitis

A. Commonly affects lambs and goats, particularly after castration and/or tail docking

Copper Toxicity

B. Caused by an imbalance of the calcium to phosphorus ratio

Coccidiosis

C. Clinical signs include: watery/bloody diarrhea, weight loss, lethargy, and dehydration

Urinary Calculi

D. Commonly known as overeating disease

Tetanus

E. Caused by improper feeding of mixed rations containing high levels of copper

Enterotoxemia

F. Clinical signs include: excessive watering of the eye and clouding of the pupil
